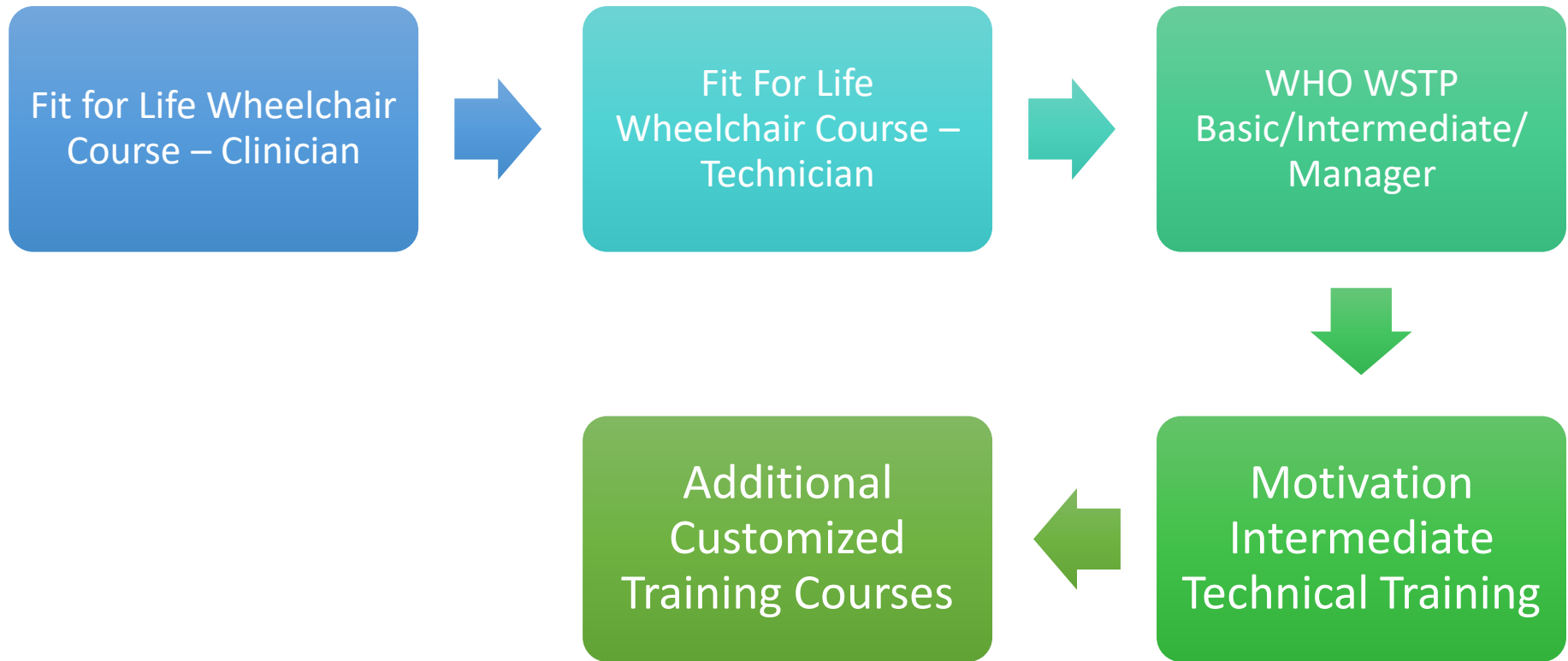

Wheelchair Training courses

- Fit for Life Wheelchair Course – Clinician (2 Weeks)
- Fit for Life Wheelchair Course – Technician (2 Weeks)
- WHO WSTP Basic- 5 Days To 9 Days
- WHO WSTP Intermediate Level- 7days To 11 Days
- WHO WSTP Managers Level- 2-3 Days
- Motivation Intermediate Technical Training- 9- 12 Days



Motivation's training packages

- Motivation Peer training- 5 days
- Motivation TOT peer training- 5 days
- Parent care training – 6 days
- Wheelchair Referral and screening training- 2-3 days



Mentoring support

- Modified Wheelchair Assessment and Fitting Training – 2- 3 Days
- Wheelchair Repair and Maintenance Training – 1 Day
- Awareness on Wheelchair Training- 1 Day (Importance of Wheelchair Training and Service Provision)

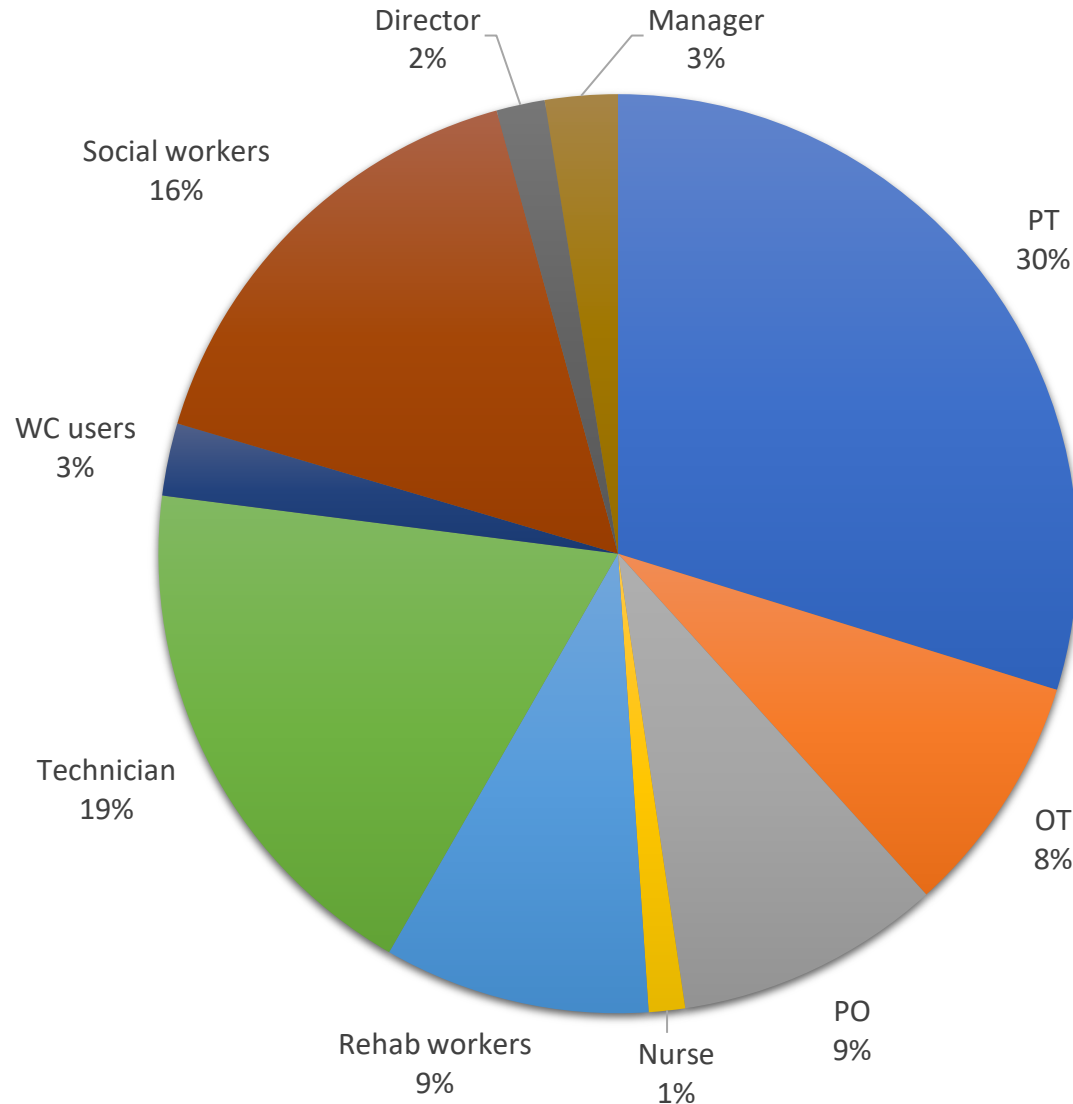
Since 2011

- More than 300 People Received Mentoring Support

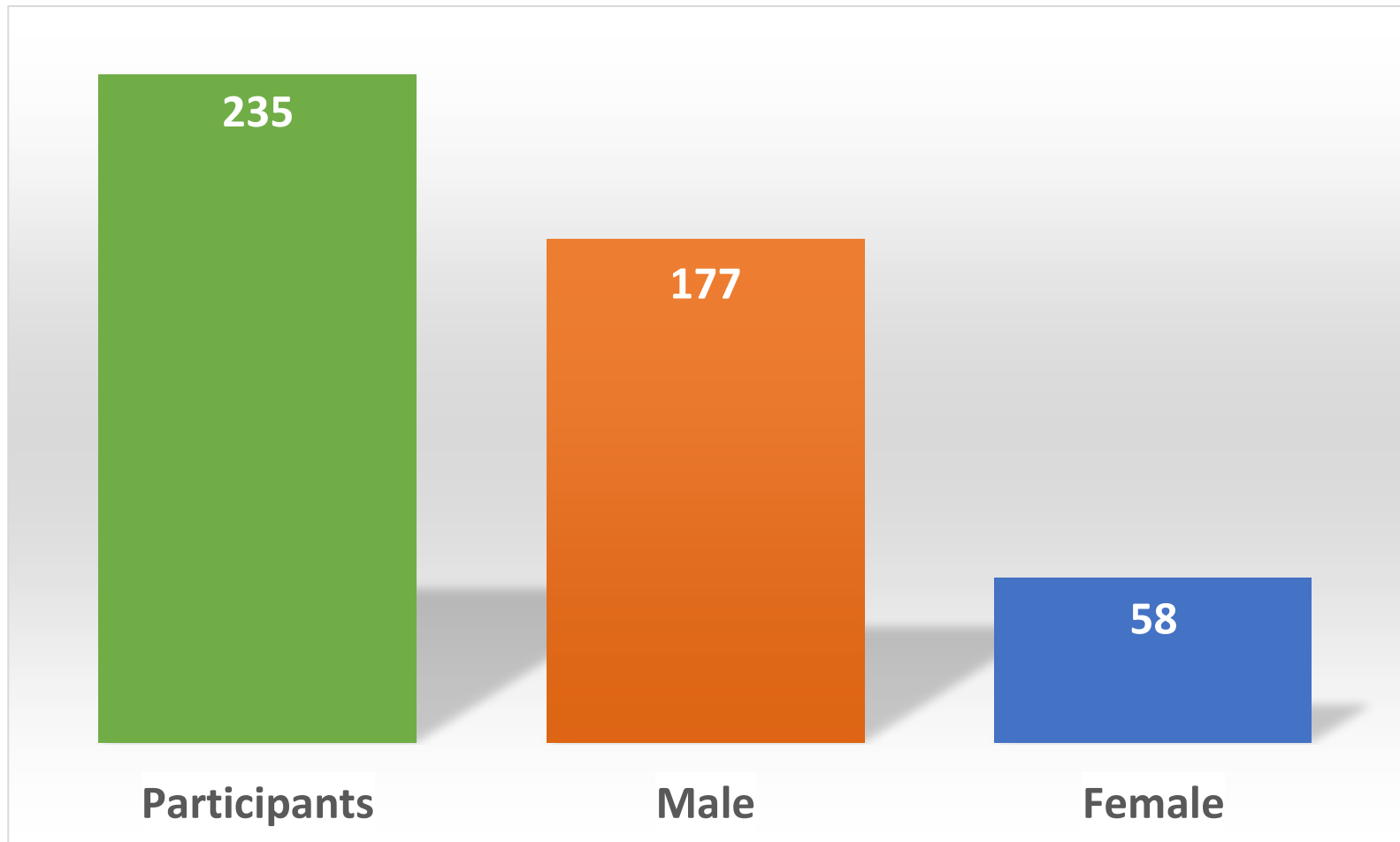

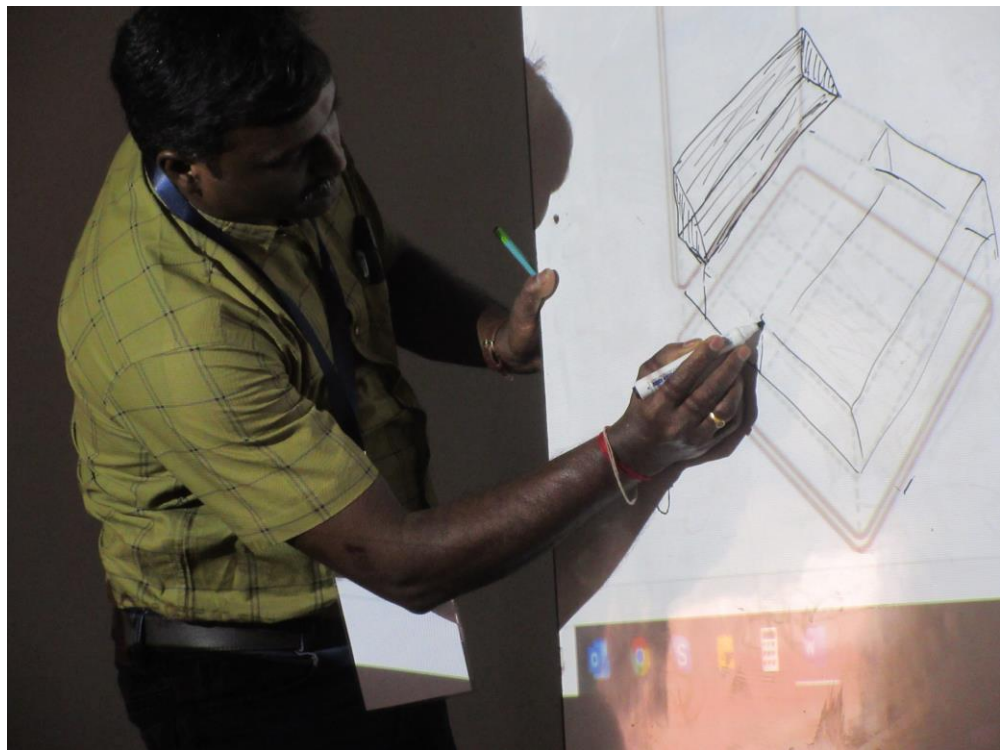

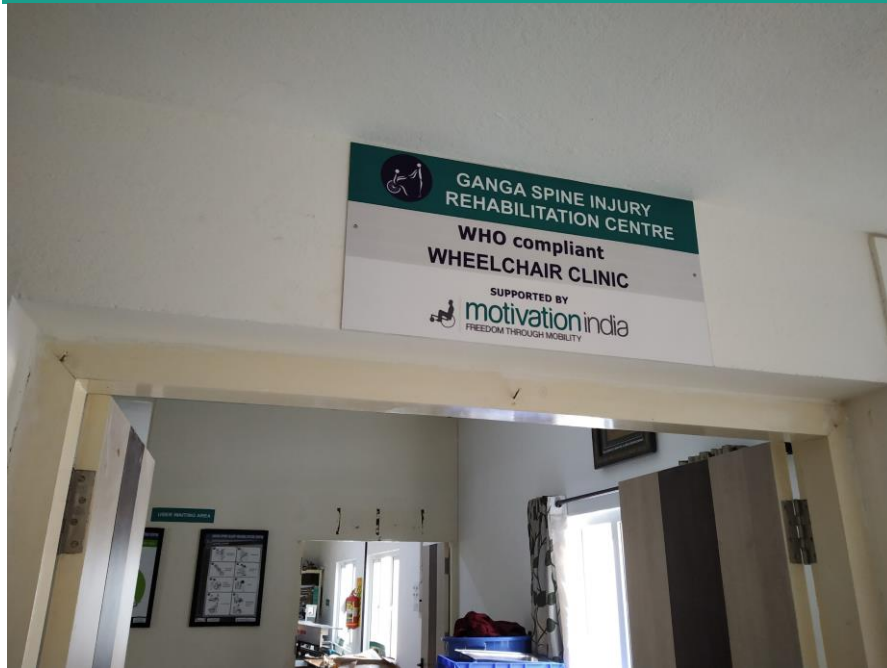
